

Frequently Asked Questions



Yucaipa Rodeo consists of both roughstock or judged events (bareback, saddle bronc and bull riding) and timed events (steer wrestling, tie-down and team roping, and barrel racing) during each performance.

Q: Are each of the rodeo performances the same?

A: Yes! Both performances host the same events and specialty acts. Each day has different competitors so it's still different enough to enjoy coming to both performances!

Q: How long does it last?

A: Each performance lasts approximately two to three hours.

Q: When do the gates open?

A: Gates open at 4pm on Friday and 2pm on Saturday.

Q: What is the parking fee?

A: \$5.00 per vehicle on Friday. \$7.00 per vehicle on Saturday.

Q: Is there handicapped seating available? Parking?

A: Yes, both are available. Wheelchair seating plus one companion will be available in designated areas. Handicapped parking will also be available in designated areas.

Q: Is there VIP seating?

A: New in 2020, there is the option to purchase a VIP package which includes premium seating, parking, dinner, and 2 complementary drinks!

Q: Are there assigned seats? How do we know where to sit?

A: The seats are not numbered and seating is on a first come first serve basis. We ask that you please be courteous and make room for others so that all ticket holders have a place to sit. Thank you!

Q: May I bring my children to the Rodeo?

A: Yes! All ages are welcome. Small children three and under, that do not occupy a seat, are free.

Q: Can I bring a bag or a purse?

A: Yes, but please be aware that ALL bags / backpacks are subject to search.

Q: May I bring my dog?

A: No, pets of any kind are not permitted at the rodeo.

Q: Can I bring food & drinks?

A: No food, beverage, containers, or weapons of any kind are allowed to be brought in at this venue. Food, Beverage, and merchandise vendors are available on site.

Q: Is this a non-smoking event?

A: Smoking is prohibited including e-cigarettes.

Q: What is your refund policy?

A: No refunds or exchanges.

Q: What if it rains?

A: The rodeo will be held unless it is potentially dangerous for the contestants and/or livestock. Rodeo is typically a rain or shine event.

Q: What should I wear to the rodeo?

A: Put on your favorite hat and boots! Festive, cowboy attire is always welcome, but not required. Comfortable clothing with a jacket or sweater is recommended if joining us in the evening.
